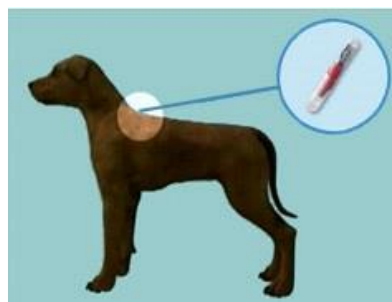

- uses an appropriate format.

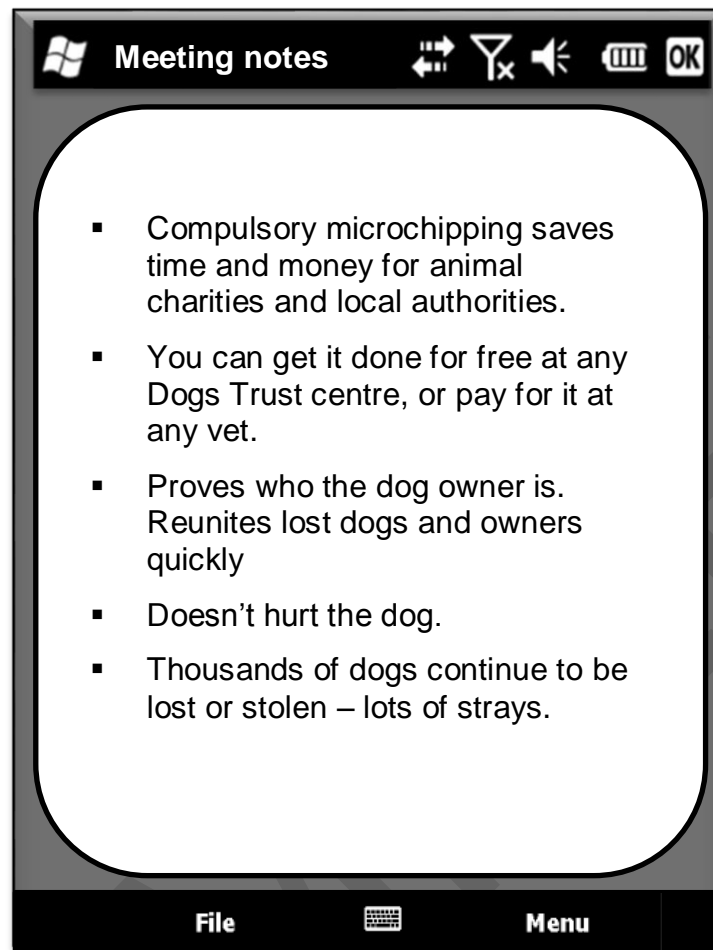
